Advisory to staff, volunteers and patrons of St. Mary's Catholic Church – 680 Clydesdale Road, Apsley, ON

Today, Peterborough Public Health became aware of a potential exposure to COVID-19 at **St. Mary's Catholic Church** located at 680 Clydesdale Road in Apsley, Ontario on April 4, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Peterborough Public Health is advising anyone who attended the church during that period to be aware of this exposure. If you have symptoms, or develop any new or worsening symptoms compatible with COVID-19 (listed below) you are asked to immediately self-isolate and seek testing.

- Fever or chills
- Cough or shortness of breath
- Muscle aches, joint pain and tiredness
- Difficulty breathing (shortness of breath)
- Sore throat or difficulty swallowing
- Headache
- Runny nose or stuffy (congested) nose
- New loss of taste or smell
- Gastrointestinal symptoms (e.g., nausea, vomiting, stomach pain, diarrhea)
