**Advisory to staff, volunteers and patrons of St. Mary's Catholic Church – 680 Clydesdale Road, Apsley, ON**

Today, Peterborough Public Health became aware of a potential exposure to COVID-19 at **St. Mary's Catholic Church** located at 680 Clydesdale Road in Apsley, Ontario on April 4, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

Peterborough Public Health is advising anyone who attended the church during that period to be aware of this exposure. **If you have symptoms, or develop any new or worsening symptoms compatible with COVID-19 (listed below) you are asked to immediately self-isolate and seek testing.**

- Fever or chills
- Cough or shortness of breath
- Muscle aches, joint pain and tiredness
- Difficulty breathing (shortness of breath)
- Sore throat or difficulty swallowing
- Headache
- Runny nose or stuffy (congested) nose
- New loss of taste or smell
- Gastrointestinal symptoms (e.g., nausea, vomiting, stomach pain, diarrhea)
