



Roman Catholic Diocese of Peterborough

The Roman Catholic Diocese of Peterborough is served by six local Health Units:

- Peterborough,
- Haliburton-Kawartha-Pine Ridge;
- Hastings-Prince Edward;
- Simcoe-Muskoka;
- Durham; and
- North Bay-Parry Sound.

The regional Health Units issue Orders under the authority of Ontario Regulation 263/20 under the provincial Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act (EMCPA). Additionally, the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) issues Registrar's Directives that apply to the arrangements for funerals. A summary of the Orders and the BAO Directive in place within the different jurisdictions follows.

Peterborough Public Health Unit – Face coverings are mandatory in commercial establishments and on public transit service and commercial transportation service as of August 1, 2020. Face masks are strongly encouraged but not mandatory in churches.
